Sri Sharada Education Institutes General Rules

1. Every Pupil Must possess the school Calender which should be brought to school daily, failing which he/she is liable to be sent home.
2. Pupils must be present in the school premises fifteen minutes before the school starts. No. Pupil will be allowed to leave the school during recess.
3. Late -comers without a written reason from the Parents will be sent home.
4. A pupil who is habitually late comes to school without proper uniform and does not abide by the school rules will be asked to leave the school.
5. Irregular attendance want of application in subordination to teachers and any kind of cheating or any habit or misbehaviour objectionable to the good tone of the school are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a student.
6. Any kind of damage done in school premises shall have to be made good. All should be particularly careful not to throw papers seeds etc anywhere except in the basket provided for that purpose.
7. The School cannot make itself responsible for books, money, clothes and other articles that are lost. The student must look after their things. It is not advisable for pupils to have money or gold ornaments with them.
8. Students are strictly instructed to speak only in English in the school premises in order to acquire fluency in spoken English.
9. Pupils are expected to take part in all co-curricular activities as well as their civic training and no one will be excused except for grave reasons.
10. Without previous sanction of the principal no collection for any purpose will be made the reason. whatsoever could be no presents to be made to the members of the staff. no meeting parties, picnics or demonstrations could be arranged.
11. Parents and guardians should examine the calendar and different reports and guide their children accordingly.
12. Parents and guardians are advised to co-operate with the school authorities to inculcate a sense of discipline and regularity in their wards.

- Students coming to school after a contagious or infectious disease should produce a Doctor's certificate permitting him/her to do so. The school accepts no responsibility if, through failure in producing such certificate a student is obliged to return home during the class hours.
- All are expected to attend school on the reopening day after every vacation. Absence for more than two class days, renders the pupil liable to be struck off the rolls.

Admission and Withdrawal

- Pupils coming from a recognised school are required to produce a leaving Certificate from the last school they have attended. They should appear for a written test also.
- If the candidate comes from outside the state of Karnataka, the leaving Certificate must be countersigned by the Educational officer of the State in which the school is situated.
- Only Students who are between the age of five and seven years will be admitted to the I standard and a corresponding scale of age is fixed for other standards.
- When admitted they will have to pay an admission fee, term fee for the current year.
- Leaving certificate will be given to those who will produce a written application from their parents or guardians and have settled all their dues.
- Pupils joining or leaving the school during any term should pay the fees for the entire year.
- If no notice of withdrawal before the end of the term is given full fees for the second term will be charged.
- Leaving Certificate will be given fees of charge if taken immediately when leaving. Otherwise a search fee of Rs. 10/- will be charged for getting any extract School records.
- Admission starts from 1st January every year. The parents along with the wards should see the principal between 10-00 a.m. to 12-00 noon.

Dismissal

The Following reasons warrant dismissal

1. Repeated absence for feasts, wedding etc.
2. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence for more than seven days.
3. Habitual idleness, disobedience or objectionable moral influence.
4. Frequent failures to obtain "good" in conduct or application.
5. Bad conduct in and out of school or misbehaviour in public streets and conveyance.

School Fees

For new admissions, full fees should be paid at the time of admission

- * Fee should be paid either in full or in two installments

First Installment	by 30-06-2022
Second installment	by 30-10-2022

A late fee of Rs. 10/- per day will be collected after the due date

- * Students will appear for the examination only after the clearance of all the school dues.
- * Fee once collected will not be refunded for any reason.
- * T.C. will be issued only after the clearance of all the school dues.

Promotion

1. Promotion will be decided on the whole year's progress based on Periodic Test.
2. Promotion from one standard to another will be made at the end of the school year.
3. The promotion of pupil who for reason, like illness are prevented from appearing for the final examination will be decided on the progress during the year.
4. The decision of the Principal shall be final in all cases.

Some Suggestion to Parents

1. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school Authorities by enforcing regularity punctuality and discipline and to ensure that the children or wards prepare their lessons and take an active interest and are helpful in school activities.
2. Parents are particularly expected to sign messages, the progress report or any other similar documents when so required. Failure to do this may put their children to great inconvenience. They should also keep an eye on the late attendance, report etc in the calendar. Explanations should be written in ink in school calendar only.
